## Beef BBQ and Chicken Noodle Soup Recipes

1 tablespoon of butter  
1/2 cup of chopped onion  
1/2 cup of chopped celery  
4 (14.5 ounce cans of chicken broth)  
1 can of cream of celery soup  
1 can of cream chicken soup  
1/2 pound of cooked chicken breast  
1 1/2 cups of egg noodles  
1 cup of sliced carrots  
Basil, salt & pepper to taste



Melt the butter in pan, add celery and onion. Once tender add remaining ingredients. Double ingredients as needed for quantity.



For 1 pound of hamburger  
1/2 cup of ketchup, 1/4 cup of brown sugar and two tablespoons of vinegar (I usually use apple cider vinegar but white will work to taste because some ketchups are sweeter than others.
