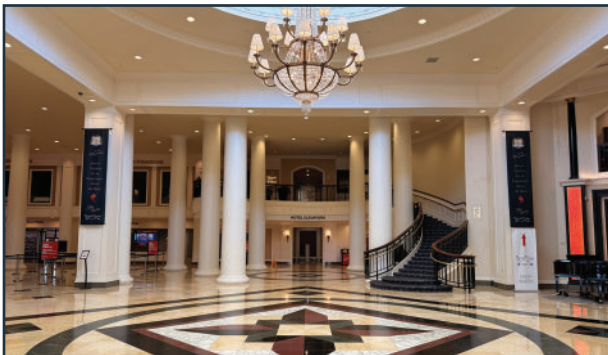

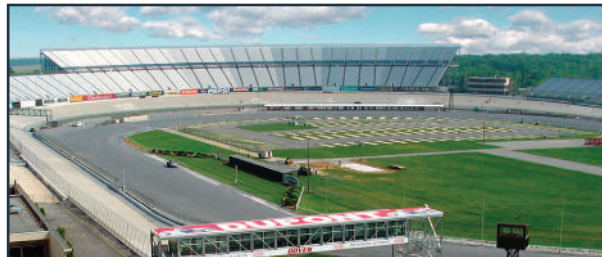

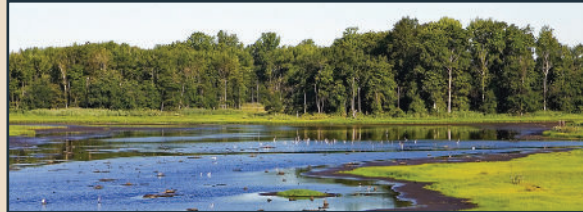

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Monday, September 21

Monday is an optional tour day. If you choose to tour on Monday, you will enjoy a leisurely cruise through the **Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge** with a stop in the Visitor Center. Afterwards, it's on to the **Johnson Victrola Museum**. Then you will return to the hotel to get ready for the **Opening Banquet**. The Opening Banquet will be held at the **Modern Maturity Center**.



Tuesday, September 22

For Tuesday, the group will split into two groups for the touring day.

- Group A will visit the **Historic Lewes Town Campus, Lightship Overfalls and Museum, and Fort Miles Coastal Defense Museum and Park**.
- Group B will drive their cars onto the **Cape May-Lewes Ferry** for a crossing of Delaware Bay and tour around **Cape May, New Jersey**, before returning.

Wednesday, September 23

Wednesday takes us to the **Hagley Museum**, the **Marshall Steam Museum**, and **New Castle First State Historic Park**, followed by an afternoon ice cream stop in **Chesapeake City, Maryland**.



Thursday, September 24

Thursday is the same tour as Tuesday, but the groups are reversed.

- Group A will drive their cars onto the **Cape May-Lewes Ferry** for a crossing of Delaware Bay and tour around **Cape May, New Jersey**, before returning.
- Group B will visit the **Historic Lewes Town Campus, Lightship Overfalls and Museum, and Fort Miles Coastal Defense Museum and Park**.

Friday, September 25

The group will again split into the same Group A and Group B as before.

- Group A will visit the **Delaware Agricultural Museum** in the morning.
- Group B will visit the **Air Mobility Command Museum** in the morning.

Both groups will come back together for lunch at Pit Row **Dover Motor Speedway** followed by parade laps around the track.

- Group A will visit the **Air Mobility Command Museum** in the afternoon.
- Group B will visit the **Delaware Agricultural Museum** in the afternoon.

Once everyone has returned to the hotel and grabbed a bite to eat, we will head to the **Diamond Rooms** for the **Freshman Gathering Dessert Extravaganza!**



Saturday, September 26

Saturday includes the **Massey Aerodrome Museum** and the **Mount Harmon Plantation**. Then it's back to the hotel in the afternoon to get ready for the **Closing Banquet**.
